



On May 2, 2022, COVID-19 emergency relief for federal student loans is ending.

Student loan payments will restart.

What have the COVID-19 emergency relief measures been doing?

The COVID-19 emergency relief:

- Suspended loan payments
- Put a 0% interest rate in place during the suspension
- Suspended collections on defaulted loans

What is changing on May 2, 2022?

The emergency relief measures end. Student loan payments resume.
